



Town of Halton Hills Temporary Patio Guidelines

1. Temporary patios approved in 2022 shall be permitted from May 1, 2022 until October 1, 2022. The applicant is responsible for removal of the patio no later than October 2, 2022.
2. Amplified sound is not permitted on temporary patios. Please be a responsible business operator by ensuring that the conduct of your patrons does not adversely impact your neighbours.
3. No open flames are to be used on tables or in any part of the temporary patios.
4. Electrical power cords or any device that crosses the travelled portion of the sidewalk is not permitted.
5. Allow space for the safe circulation of customers and staff.
6. Businesses must be prepared to ensure accessibility for Town staff and utility providers (i.e., electricity, gas, tree maintenance) should they require access to their assets in the public realm.
7. Consider a reservation system to avoid lines of waiting customers.
8. Clean and disinfect common surfaces and washrooms frequently.
9. Opt to use contactless payment systems and avoid handling money as much as possible.
10. Be aware of the most current, credible public health information/recommendations, and communicate these to your employees and the public.
11. If the Town supplies barriers for your patio, you are responsible for the sanitation of these barriers. Please report any damages or maintenance required to the Town at Valeriep@haltonhills.ca
