



As one of North America's leading manufacturers and suppliers of work gloves, Superior Glove has been making gloves since 1910.

Today, the company is the most flexible and vertically integrated glove manufacturer in Canada, specializing in cut-resistant gloves made from high-tech composite yarns with specialized grips and wear resistant polymer coatings.

Superior Glove produces over 3,500 different styles of gloves – the result of a proactive R&D department that helps bring to market dozens of new technically innovative products each year that win numerous awards. Their in-house engineering team

recently designed and built 'Henry', a robotic maker of cut-resistant sleeves for users who work around sharp objects.

The company manufacturers all their products in factories located in Halton Hills Ontario, Point Leamington Newfoundland, Buffalo New York, Springdale Newfoundland, and Honduras. With corporate headquarters in Halton Hills, Superior Glove employs 430 people across Canada and the United States, including 150 at their Halton Hills facility.

Superior Glove has won several awards including Canada's Safest Manufacturing Employer Excellence Award, being named one of Canada's Best Managed Companies, and being one of Canada's Top 100 Employers.





OVINO

OVINO is Canada's largest dairy sheep farm, producing milk in three fat-percentages, a Balkan-style yogurt, feta and halloumi cheese.

Brothers Jay and Frank Akras founded OVINO to provide a healthy dairy alternative to the 70% of people with cow milk sensitivities. Sheep milk offers superior digestibility and is more nutritious — containing almost twice as much protein and much higher concentrations of minerals, vitamins, and folic acid.

"We've found a niche that wasn't being served. There is significant and growing demand for sheep milk for its nutritional value, flavour, and digestibility," explains Jay. "Sheep milk is the perfect alternative for people who are lactose intolerant."

OVINO uses state-of-the-art automation technology to ensure future production capacity. Feeding and bedding equipment runs on an overhead automated monorail system which helps reduce the cost of labour.



Intlvac Thin Film is high-tech company, located in Halton Hills' Georgetown Industrial Area, that has specialized in high vacuum components and systems for a variety of specific outcomes since 1967.

Recently, the company established a new business unit: Intlvac Hydrogen. Intlvac Hydrogen possesses the capabilities to scale up the production of bipolar plate coatings for fuel cells and electrolyzers. "Hydrogen/fuel cells is a very exciting market opportunity for us, as our technology is ideally suited for the sector.

We recognized early that the importance of reducing the cost of producing fuel cells, to make them economically viable, was a massive hurdle that the industry needed to overcome," explains Intlvac's President, Dino Deligiannis.

The company's technology can reduce the amount of expensive

and scarce noble metals used in fuel cell construction by up to 90%. This enormous reduction in scarce noble metals not only drives down cost but is also a sustainable solution for the volume deployment of fuel cell technology in many applications.

Intlvac is a driving force in the thin film deposition and materials science industry with customers in the aerospace, defence, medicine, telecommunications, energy, hydrogen/fuel cells, optics and photonics industries.
